ABOUT

This Privacy Policy applies between you the 'User' of this website and **ur point**. **ur point** is a subsidiary of Ur International Group, the owner of this website. Ur International Group can be contacted at: Ur International Group, The Hangars, Harbury Lane Leamington, Warwickshire, United Kingdom, CV33 9SA

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ur point respects your privacy and is committed to protecting your personal data. This privacy policy will inform you as to how we look after your personal data when you visit ur point (regardless of where you visit it from) and tell you about your privacy rights and how the law protects you.

Please also use the Glossary to understand the meaning of some of the terms used in this Privacy Policy.

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

-  GDPR – General Data Protection Regulation.
-  Data – The information that you submit to **ur point**.
-  User – You, and/or other **ur point** members, or people who use the website or are subscribed as a member of **ur point**.
-  The Website – www.ur-point.com. This is the website that you are currently on. This includes all subpages contained on the same domain.
-  We – **ur point** may be referred to as “we” or “us”.
-  You – Is you, the user of the website.
-  Data Controller – **ur point** & Ur International Group Ltd.

DATA THAT WE COLLECT

All of the information that you input to www.ur-point.com for your subscription, and your profile is classed as your personal data that we store on the website. The data will consist of your name, address, date of birth, mobile phone number, email address, and passwords. None of this data will be passed onto any third-party.

For subscriptions for additional storage or membership, you may be required to input bank details into a secure payment service. **ur point** do not store your bank details. All card pays will be taken in compliance to the [Official PCI Security Standards](#).

Information may also be stored that remembers your preferences when using the website.

Where ur point need to collect personal data by law, or under the terms of a contract we have with you, and you fail to provide that data when requested, ur point may not be able to perform the contract ur point have or are trying to enter into with you. In this case, ur point may have to cancel a product or service you have with ur point.



WEBSITE SECURITY

ur point take security seriously and have implemented backend security to ensure that nobody can access the information that you provide to us. All profile information and log on details are stored in a secure cloud-server with additional security provided by the 'Cloud Services Provider'. It should be noted that the cloud service provider cannot access your personal data.

HOW UR POINT USE YOUR PERSONAL DATA

ur point will only use your personal data when the law allows us to. Most commonly, ur point will use your personal data in the following circumstances:

- Where ur point need to perform the contract we are about to enter into or have entered into with you.
- Where it is necessary for our legitimate interests (or those of a third party) and your interests and fundamental rights do not override those interests.
- Where we need to comply with a legal obligation.

LENGTH OF TIME THAT DATA IS STORED

For as long as you subscribe to www.ur-point.com we will store your personal details and log on information, so we are able to fulfil our obligations to you as a member of **ur point**. Should you choose to leave **ur point** in the future, we will delete all of the private information that we have about you in the correct amount of time, as required by GDPR Regulation and UK Law.





DATA PROCESSING

THE INFORMATION THAT YOU (THE USER) PROVIDE TO UR POINT WILL BE PROCESSED, WITH YOUR CONSENT, BY US, TO ENABLE US TO FULFIL OUR CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATIONS TO YOU AS A SIGNED-UP MEMBER OF UR POINT.

CERTAIN PROCESSING OF DATA IS REQUIRED TO ENSURE THAT UR POINT ARE COMPLIANT WITH LEGAL OBLIGATIONS. YOUR PERSONAL DATA WILL NOT BE PROCESSED TO ANY THIRD-PARTY AND YOUR INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS WILL BE UPHELD.

USERS CAN REQUEST THAT THEIR DATA IS NOT PROCESSED BUT THIS ONLY APPLIES IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

DELETION OF DATA

WHEN UR POINT DELETE PERSONAL DATA, IT IS SECURELY WIPED FROM ALL SERVERS, INCLUDING BACK-UP SERVERS, IN THE CORRECT AMOUNT OF TIME. IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO RETRIEVE THIS DATA ONCE IT HAS BEEN COMPLETELY DELETED.

YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS

You have the right to:

Request access to your personal data (commonly known as a "data subject access request"). This enables you to receive a copy of the personal data ur point hold about you and to check that ur point are lawfully processing it.

Request correction of the personal data that ur point hold about you. This enables you to have any incomplete or inaccurate data ur point hold about you corrected, though ur point may need to verify the accuracy of the new data you provide to us.

Request erasure of your personal data. This enables you to ask ur point to delete or remove personal data where there is no good reason for us continuing to process it. You also have the right to ask us to delete or remove your personal data where you have successfully exercised your right to object to processing (see below), where we may have processed your information unlawfully or where we are required to erase your personal data to comply with local law. Note, however, that we may not always be able to comply with your request of erasure for specific legal reasons which will be notified to you, if applicable, at the time of your request.

Object to processing of your personal data where ur point are relying on a legitimate interest (or those of a third party) and there is something about your particular situation which makes you want to object to processing on this ground as you feel it impacts on your fundamental rights and freedoms. You also have the right to object where we are processing your personal data for direct marketing purposes. In some cases, we may demonstrate that we have compelling legitimate grounds to process your information which override your rights and freedoms.

Request restriction of processing of your personal data. This enables you to ask ur point to suspend the processing of your personal data in the following scenarios:

- If you want us to establish the data's accuracy.



- Where our use of the data is unlawful but you do not want us to erase it.
- Where you need us to hold the data even if we no longer require it as you need it to establish, exercise or defend legal claims.
- You have objected to our use of your data but we need to verify whether we have overriding legitimate grounds to use it.

Request the transfer of your personal data to you or to a third party. We will provide to you, or a third party you have chosen, your personal data in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format. Note that this right only applies to automated information which you initially provided consent for us to use or where we used the information to perform a contract with you.

Withdraw consent at any time where we are relying on consent to process your personal data. However, this will not affect the lawfulness of any processing carried out before you withdraw your consent. If you withdraw your consent, we may not be able to provide certain products or services to you. We will advise you if this is the case at the time you withdraw your consent.
